**1. Professor** in the scale of pay of Rs.37400-67000 with academic grade pay of Rs.10000 plus allowances as per Institute's rules. Total emoluments at the minimum of the scale will be Rs.1.12.564/- per month. **Age:** Preferably 45 years (relaxable by Selection Committee in deserving cases).

**Qualifications Essential:** (i) A creditable academic record with Ph.D in Economics and specialization in the relevant area (ii) Publications of high standard and (iii) at least 10 years' research or teaching experience in a University or Govt. or a reputed research Institution.

**Desirable:** Experience in empirical analysis of macro-fiscal, public finance issues and policy modeling.

**2. Associate Professor** in the scale of pay of Rs.37400-67000 with academic grade pay of Rs.9000 plus allowances as per Institute's rules. Total emoluments at the minimum of the scale will be around Rs.99,232/- per month.

**Qualifications Essential** (i) A creditable academic record with Ph.D in Economics and specialization in **macroeconomic policy, public finance** areas with a good background in quantitative economics (ii) Publications in Standard Journals and (iii) 8 years experience in research or teaching

**Desirable**- Experience in empirical analysis of macro-fiscal policy issues on public economics.

**3. Assistant Professor** in the scale of pay of Rs.15600-39100 with academic grade pay of Rs.7000 plus allowances as per Institute's rules. Total emoluments at the minimum of the scale will be around Rs.57,216/- per month.

**Qualifications Essential** Post Graduate in Economics with specialization **in macroeconomic policy and/or public finance** (ii) Ph.D. degree obtained on the basis of dissertation in the relevant area, (iii) knowledge of quantitative techniques, and (iv) publications of good standard
