## Abstract

This pioneering study on gender budgeting in India aims at (i) *gender diagnosis* to analyse the existing degree of gender asymmetry in socio-economic development; (ii) valuation of the statistically invisible *care economy* within the framework of Systems of National Accounts (SNA) 1993 using the *timeuse* budgets; (iii) econometric investigation of the link between fiscal policies and gender development; (iv) *ex-post* analysis of the national budgets through a gender lens and (v) prescribe policy suggestions to build-in a gender-sensitive national budgeting process.
